SPECIFIC FOOD PROCESSING SCHEMES

**4416. DR. T. SUMATHY (A) THAMIZHACHI THANGAPANDIAN:
SHRI D.M. KATHIR ANAND:**

Will the Minister of **FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the State of Tamil Nadu has ranked 2nd in terms of food processing units and contributes around 10 percent to India's national food processing output;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the funds allocated for the development of food processing industries in Tamil Nadu;
- (c) whether the Government has initiated any specific food processing schemes in Tamil Nadu which is India's leading producer of mangoes, bananas, turmeric, tapioca, tamarind, coconuts, groundnuts, cashews, papaya, maize, beans, grapes and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether the Union Government has provided funds for setting up 6 mega food parks and 15 small food parks/agro processing clusters in Tamil Nadu where units will be eligible for capital investment subsidy and other incentives and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): As per Annual Survey of Industries 2019-20, the number of registered Food Processing Units in Tamil Nadu is 4995 that ranked 2nd in terms of food processing units all over the country. The total output reported as Rs. 99656.33 Crores, contributes 7.5% to the country's output.

The Ministry of Food Processing industries (MoFPI) has been implementing Central Sector Umbrella Scheme - Pradhan Mantri Kisan SAMPADA Yojana (PMKSY), centrally sponsored PM Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises Scheme (PMFME) and Production Linked Incentive Scheme (PLISFPI) for overall growth and development of food processing sector including mangoes, bananas, turmeric, tapioca, tamarind, coconuts, groundnuts, cashews, papaya, maize, beans, grapes based processing industries across the country including Tamil Nadu.

Under component schemes of PMKSY, MoFPI provides mostly credit linked financial assistance (capital subsidy) in the form of grants-in-aid to entrepreneurs for setting up of food processing / preservation industries. PMKSY is not region or state specific but demand driven with no state-wise fund allocation. Ministry provides financial, technical and business support for setting up/upgradation of micro food processing enterprises under PMFME scheme. Funds of Rs. 22.31 Cr. has so far been released under the PMFME scheme to the state. One District One Product (ODOP) approved under PMFME for the state is placed at **Annexure-I**. PLISFPI is targeted to facilitate expansion of food processing capacity by creating champion brands in Food Processing Sector and there is no state-wise allocation of fund under this scheme.

(d): So far, Ministry has approved 1 Mega Food Park and 11 Agro Processing Clusters / Mini Food Parks for assistance under corresponding component schemes of PMKSY in Tamil Nadu; where Food Processing units are eligible for subsidy @ 35% of eligible project cost in general areas and @50% of eligible project cost for `Scheduled Caste/ Schedule Tribe promoters and Self Help Groups subject to maximum of Rs. 5.00 crore per project. The details of approved MFP & APC projects are placed at **Annexure-II**.
