(e) if so, the details thereof?

(a) and (b) The Ministry is not considering to shut down any ongoing National Highway (NH) project. However, in some cases, projects that are delayed substantially due to some reason(s), are either foreclosed or terminated on case to case basis and those projects are usually re-awarded subsequently as separate work.
